RYAN MACKENZIE VOTED FOR OVER \$1 TRILLION IN HEALTH CARE CUTS

Now Pennsylvanians are losing coverage, facing higher costs, and watching access to care disappear across the Lehigh Valley.

Last year, **Ryan Mackenzie voted with Donald Trump** to slash over **\$1 trillion** from Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act to pay for lavish tax cuts for billionaires and big corporations. New Medicaid eligibility limits will kick millions off coverage, while funding restrictions rip away money from hospitals, clinics, and nursing homes. They also ended the ACA premium tax credits that made coverage affordable for 22 million people – forcing working families to absorb skyrocketing premiums.

In PA-07, a health care facility has already closed after Ryan Mackenzie’s vote sparked this crisis. For many Pennsylvanians, getting care means traveling farther, waiting longer, paying more – or going without it altogether. While Mackenzie campaigns with Donald Trump, Pennsylvanians are struggling to pay their bills and access the care they need.

Ryan Mackenzie claimed the bill he voted for “protects and strengthens Medicaid.”

The reality tells a very different story.

THE PREMIUM SHOCK

FAMILIES ARE PAYING THOUSANDS MORE EVERY YEAR

For Pennsylvanians who buy their own coverage, the premium spikes are staggering:

45-year-old \$64,000 INCOME	+\$811 INCREASE	\$6,251 NEW ANNUAL PREMIUM
60-year-old couple \$85,000 INCOME	+\$16,271 INCREASE	\$23,496 NEW ANNUAL PREMIUM
Family of four \$130,000 INCOME	+\$6,637 INCREASE	\$17,687 NEW ANNUAL PREMIUM

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My premium is more than doubling, from under \$200 to over \$500 a month, so I switched to a low-premium, high-deductible plan. It's crappy coverage. I'd rather pay the \$200 a month – but I can't get anything for \$200.

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My premium jumped \$300 a month, from \$400 to \$700, when the subsidies dropped. Last year I was paycheck to paycheck; this year, without cutting anything, I'll be in the negative. I've had to save pills at the end of my prescriptions and make sacrifices at the grocery store.
